POUGHILL VILLAGE HALL 100 CLUB RULES

PURPOSE

The purpose of the Poughill Village Hall 100 Club is to raise funds to maintain and develop facilities for the Village Hall as a resource for the community.

RULES

1. For a cost of £1 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between 1 and 100. The number allocated shall remain the member's for as long as their subscription is up to date. The fee for each number will be paid annually in advance (i.e. £12 per year) by cheque or cash.
2. Each member may purchase more than one number.
3. A draw will be made once a month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
4. The prizes will total 50% of the monthly income. This will be apportioned as: 1st prize of 25%, 2nd prize of 15% and 3rd prize of 10%.
5. The 100 Club is a run as a small society lottery registered with Mid-Devon District Council (Regn. No. MDV SL0294).
6. Members must be age 16 or over.
7. The year runs from 1st March to 28th/29th February. Individuals can join at any time during the year by paying the remaining annual fee. One month's notice is required for cancellation.
8. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
9. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
10. The draw shall be made once a month at the Poughill Village Hall Committee meeting (usually the first Tuesday of the month, with the exception of January when the meeting is held on the last Tuesday of the month).
11. All reasonable efforts will be made to post the winning cheque to the address on your membership application form within one week of the draw.
12. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be displayed on the Village Hall notice board, published on the Poughill Village Hall website (<https://poughillvillage.000webhostapp.com>) and emailed to Poughill Village Hall 100 Club members.
13. The 100 Club is run on behalf of the Poughill Village Hall Trust (Regd. Charity No. 1085444) by the Poughill Village Hall Committee. In case of any dispute the decision of the Committee is final.
14. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
15. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into Village Hall funds after six months.
16. The draw shall not commence until at least 20 numbers have been sold, and in the event that not enough tickets are sold, then the cost of all tickets bought will be refunded to the purchasers.
17. The Poughill Village Hall Committee has the power to amend or revoke these rules at their absolute discretion with such reasonable notice to the 100 Club members as is necessary.
